Maths

- Show an awareness of numbers in the environment.
- Recites numbers in order to 10 and recognise some numerals.
 - Matching numeral and quantity correctly.
- Begin to represent number by marks on paper or using fingers.
 - Use positional language correctly.
 - Know 2-D shape names
- Recognise 2-D shapes in the environment and use the shapes when drawing or painting
